Simnel cake:

A Simnel Cake is an Easter fruit cake, made with lemon, dried fruits and peel, treacle and marzipan. Baked during the Easter period, it has eleven little balls of toasted marzipan on the top that Christians believe allude to the true disciples of Jesus. Judas, having betrayed Jesus, is not included.
