How Much Will It Cost?

This depends on what kind of study you want to undertake. If you want to enroll in an undergraduate or postgraduate award (credit study), then the fees are set by the University of Divinity. The fee is \$1704 per unit.

If you want to study for interest only (audit study), then the fees are \$350 per unit. Presbytery has committed to contributing \$500 per unit for people studying for credit. It may be that your congregation will financially support you too.

What Do I Need?

Access to a computer with a good internet connection, and if you are taking credit study, evidence that you fulfil the relevant admission requirements.

Presbytery are setting up a DLC – Pilgrim Stream, at Warrnambool Uniting Church in 2020 with Rev Geoff Barker the Co-ordinator. Whether this goes ahead depends on meeting the minimum number of students required by Pilgrim. That is six students, of which at least three have to be studying for credit.

Study Theology In Your Own Community

Pilgrim Theological College have a great range of theological courses that would be of interest to many people who can't come to the centre of Melbourne on a regular basis.

There is a way that you can study theology without having to travel too far. The Presbytery of Western Victoria are setting up a Discipleship Learning Community at Warrnambool offering courses with Pilgrim in 2020. This used to be called the Education Hub when it was run at Horsham.

What is the Discipleship Learning Community – Pilgrim Stream?

The Discipleship Learning Community – Pilgrim Stream is a group of people who meet to study a Pilgrim course, with the help of a tutor.

How it will work is like this:

✓ We will gather a group of people willing to enroll in and commit to a course for credit (including assessment and credit towards an undergraduate or post-graduate award) or for audit (where you do the course but not for assessment). The time commitment will be up to 10 hours per week (including the 3 hour lecture and tutorial session). There is a minimum number of students required for it to go ahead.

✓ In Semester 1 we will study 'Christianity's Big Ideas' with Geoff Thompson. In Semester 2 we will study Liturgical Theology and Practice.

✓ The group will meet at Warrnambool Uniting Church at the time the lecture is streamed- 2pm Wednesday afternoons beginning 24th February. We will watch the lecture and then have a 2 hour tutorial led by the tutor, Rev Geoff Barker, to discuss, explore and develop our learning of the subject matter together.

✓ Credit Students will complete and submit assessment tasks to Pilgrim on-line.

Pilgrim have been running Learning Hubs in a couple of locations over the past two years and this year our first graduate completed her Graduate Certificate in Divinity.
